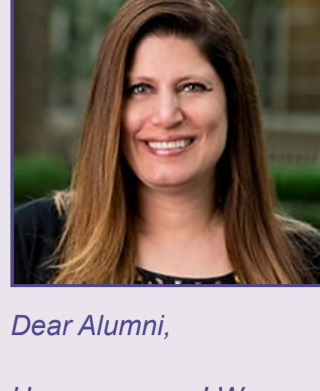

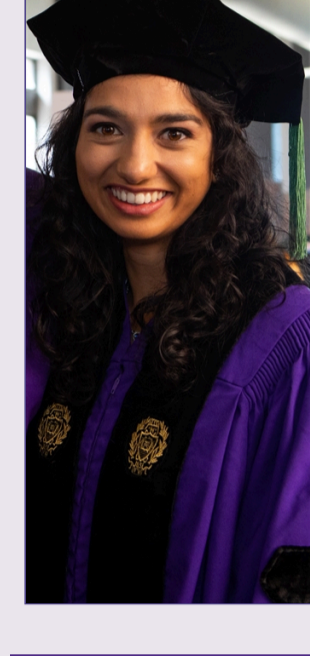
Dear Alumni,

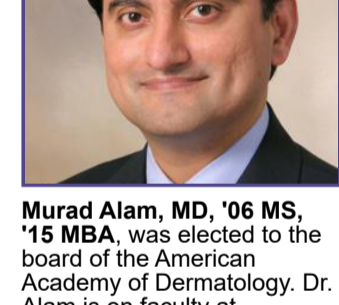

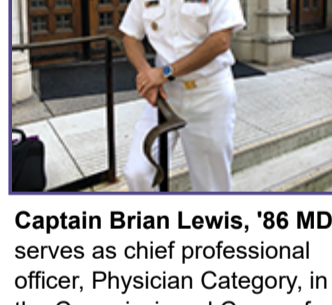
