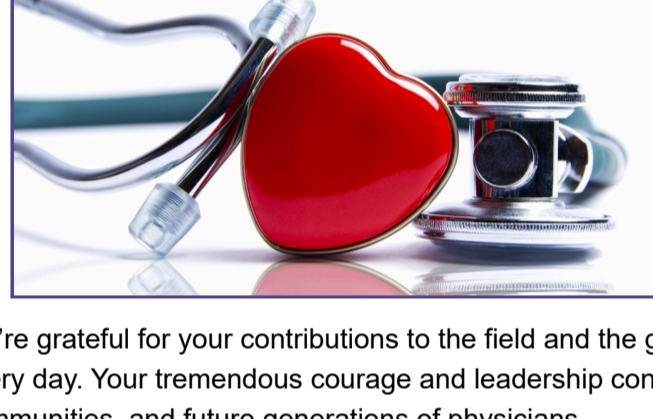

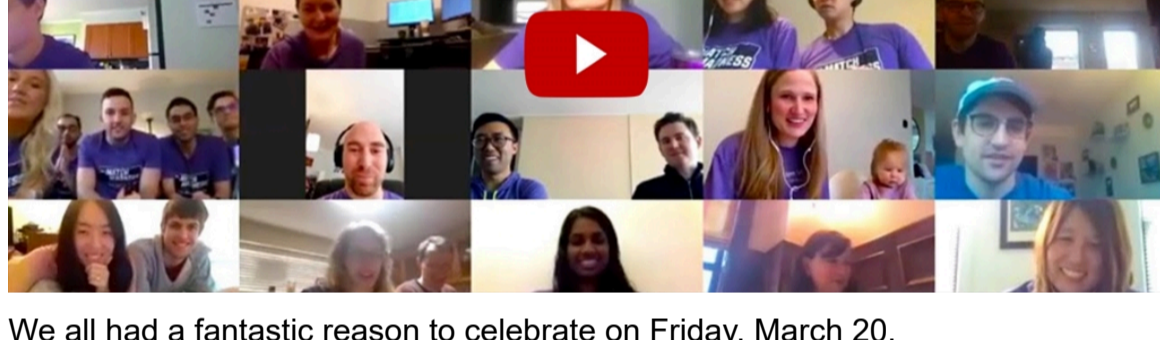
March 30 is Doctors' Day

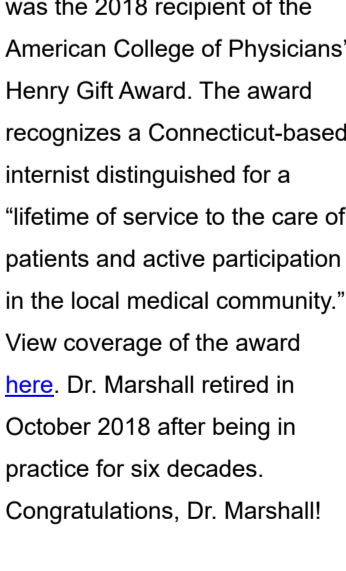
