It was so much fun meeting new friends and reconnecting with alumni in the Chicago area. Thank you to everyone who joined us!

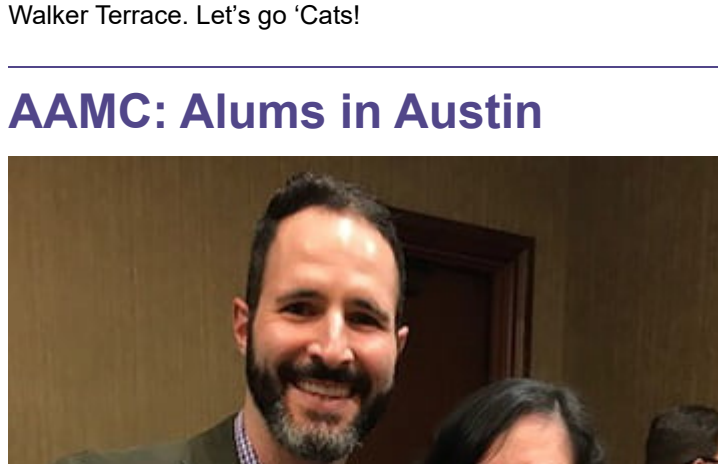
Cheering on the Wildcats

Unfortunately, the Wildcats didn't take home a win that day, but we had lots of fun cheering them on from the Randy Walker Terrace. Let's go 'Cats!

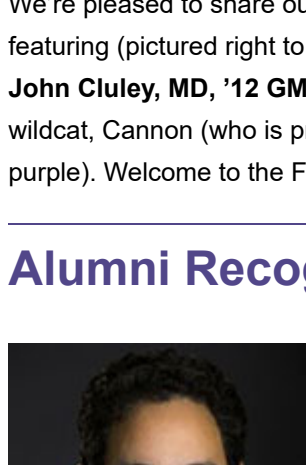
AAMC: Alums in Austin

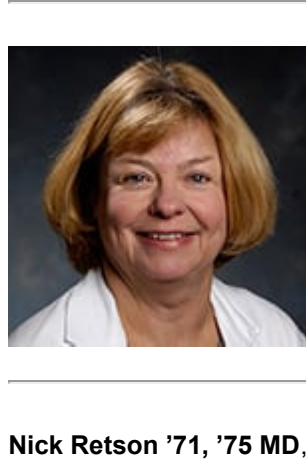
Alumni Recognition

On behalf of the doctors of Clark County, he accepted numerous awards over the past year for the treatment of those injured during the deadliest mass shooting in United States history, which took place in Las Vegas on October 1, 2017. In a 10-minute span, there were more than 400 patients with gunshot wounds, and every patient presented to the emergency room alive survived. Physicians throughout the city presented to the emergency rooms to assist in the care. We would like to recognize Dr. Adashek and all the doctors and staff of the Clark County Medical Society for their remarkable strength, resilience, and dedication to their patients.

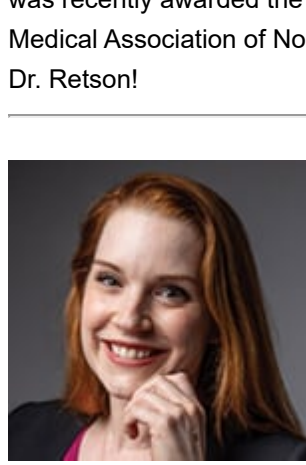
